GOODNESTONE PARISH COUNCIL MINUTES OF MEETING WEDNESDAY 11th MAY 2011

Present

Councillors Kittle, Compton, Phillips, Ellison & Plumptre.

1. Apologies

There were no apologies to record.

2. Election of Chairman

The Clerk asked for nominations for the post of Chairman. Councillor Plumptre was nominated by Councillor Kittle and seconded by Councillor Compton and was duly elected as Chairman.

3. Election of Other Offices

3.1 Vice-Chairman

Councillor Compton nominated Councillor Phillips and this was seconded by Councillor Ellison.

3.2 Footpath Officer

Councillor Plumptre nominated Councillor Kittle and this was seconded by Councillor Phillips.

3.3 Tree Officer

Councillor Phillips nominated Councillor Plumptre and this was seconded by Councillor Compton.

3.4 Internal Auditor

Councillor Plumptre nominated Councillor Compton and this was seconded by Councillor Ellison.

4. Declaration of Acceptance of Office & Register of Interests

Councillors signed the Declarations of Office and are to return their Register of Interest forms to the Clerk by 11th June.

5. Minutes of the Meeting of the 23rd March 2011

The minutes of the last Parish Council Meeting held on 23rd March were signed as a true record of events by the Chairman.

6. Matters arising not covered elsewhere in the Agenda

Councillor Ellison reported that the results of the Parish Broadband survey did not demonstrate a need great enough to apply for a grant for KCC. The group may do some publicity at the fete.

7. Community Policing

PC Keningale was not able to attend the meeting.

8. District Councillors invited to report on DDC

District Councillor Bartlett was unable to attend the meeting.

9. Affordable Housing Scheme

Work has begun on the new housing scheme, and the Parish Council's proposal to name the development Manicom Close is under consideration by DDC.

10. Planning

- **10.1** Ref: DOV/11/00242 Proposal: Erection of two storey side extension and single storey rear extension (existing extension to be demolished). Location: Huntley Lodge, Orchard Court, Chillenden The council agreed to support this application.
- **10.2** Ref: DOV/11/00245 Proposal: Erection of a two storey side extension, detached greenhouse and garden store and installation of oil tank and associated fencing. Location: Hop Cottage, Saddlers Hill, Goodnestone

The council agreed a response of ambivalent.

10.3 Ref: DOV/11/00246 (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas Act & Regulations) Proposal: Erection of a two storey side extension and associated internal alterations. Location: Hop Cottage, Saddlers Hill, Goodnestone

The council agreed a response of ambivalent.

10.4 Ref: DOV/11/00293 (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas Act & Regulations) Proposal: Erection of an attached outbuilding to be used as ancillary residential accommodation (part of existing outbuilding to be demolished) Location: Hop Cottage, Saddlers Hill, Goodnestone The council agreed a response of ambivalent.

11. Footpaths

The council agreed not to pursue the previous suggestion of installing a Kissing Gate at the entrance to the wood above Fairfield. The Clerk agreed to write to Mr Gibson to remind him that the footpath that crosses their land between Goodnestone & Chillenden should be re-established after ploughing.

12. Highway Matters

Following the proposal to install "no waiting at any time" road markings outside the school the clerk agreed to give a response asking for this not to go ahead. The reasons for this are that it is an unnecessary expense, and would be an eyesore. The clerk agreed to suggest that Kent Highways redirect the costs associated with this towards clearing the blocked drain by Park Cottage.

It was agreed that the Clerk would purchase 6 copies of "The Parish Councillor's Guide" to assist all Councillors in performing their role at a cost of approximately £15 per copy.

The Clerk read out a letter received by a parishioner asking for action to be taken regarding various highway issues. The PC decided there was not a need for a mirror to be installed on the corner of Saddler's Hill as this may distract the driver from the road. The Council were not aware of any accidents having happened on this corner and suggested drivers make use of their horns. Although the Council were sympathetic regarding the parking issues during school drop-off and pick-up times it was felt a discussion with the Head Teacher as well as PC Keningale may be more appropriate than the suggestion of parking bays.

15. Councillors Reports on Parish Matters

The Clerk agreed to put the school on the agenda as a regular item and invite Head Teacher Katy Brooks to next PC meeting.

16. Any Other Business

The Clerk agreed to send former Chairman Nick Parsons a letter and a gift to thank him for his many years of service.
