**Re: The Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 – Section 53
Claimed upgrade to Restricted Byway status of Public Bridleway EE269 at
Goodnestone and Wingham, in the District of Dover, postcode CT3 1PF**

An application has been submitted by Mr Hugh Craddock, on behalf of the British Horse Society, under Section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 that the Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way should be modified to show at Restricted Byway status the route currently shown as Public Bridleway EE269 at Goodnestone and Wingham on the basis of historical documentary evidence.

I enclose a plan showing the claimed route for your information and an extract from the Definitive Map for context.
